#### **Pocket Moments:**

Do you ever have trouble finding out what happened in your child's day after they come home from school? Well, we have something that we've introduced here at PLES that may help with this. There is a new school-wide strengths initiative called pocket moments.

The concept is to have students visualize the "best thing" that happened in their day at school. The students can either reach up and grab the "best thing" or write it down on a paper pocket.

Make sure to ask your child(ren) what their pocket moment was each day when they come home from school. We are also encouraging students and teachers to submit pocket moments to Mrs. Jones so she can read them over the announcements.

#### **Young Authors Contest**

It is time for the Young Authors Contest. It is open to 2<sup>nd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> grade students. Students should write a short story or poem. Entries must be an original work. Short story entries may range from a minimum of 300 words to 800 words. Poem entries will consist of a single poem, and should consist of a minimum of 25 words, but no more than 150 words. Entries may not have graphics. Entries must include a completed

cover sheet signed by the student author and sponsoring teacher. Entries are due to January 8, 2016. For additional information check with your child's Language Arts teacher.

#### **Training for Parent Volunteers**
