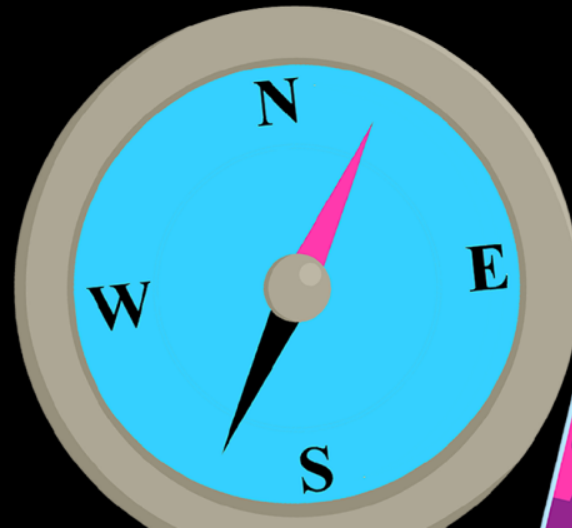

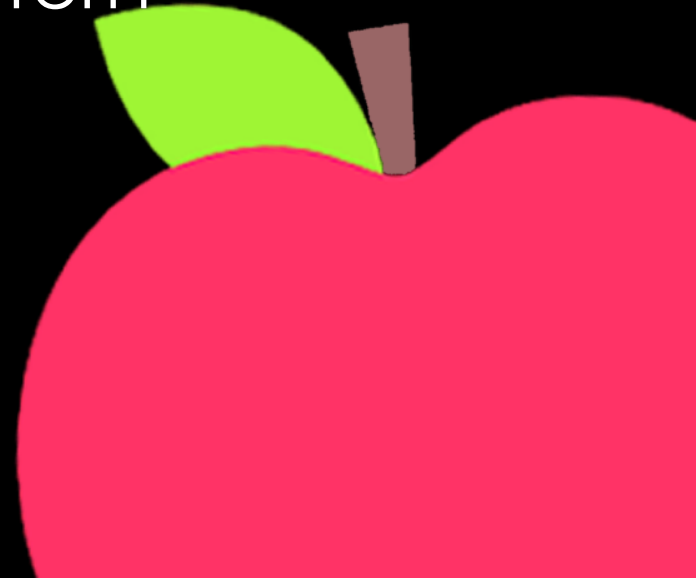

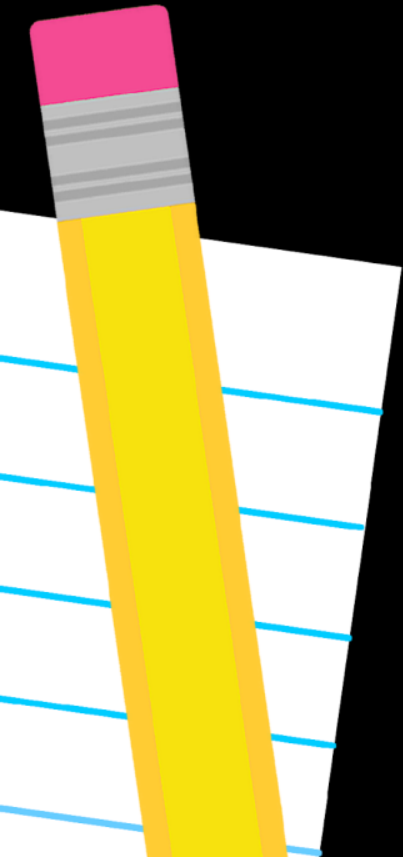

PBIS and Class Dojo

Students will be able to earn many points throughout the day for demonstrating Respect of SOP and following expectations:

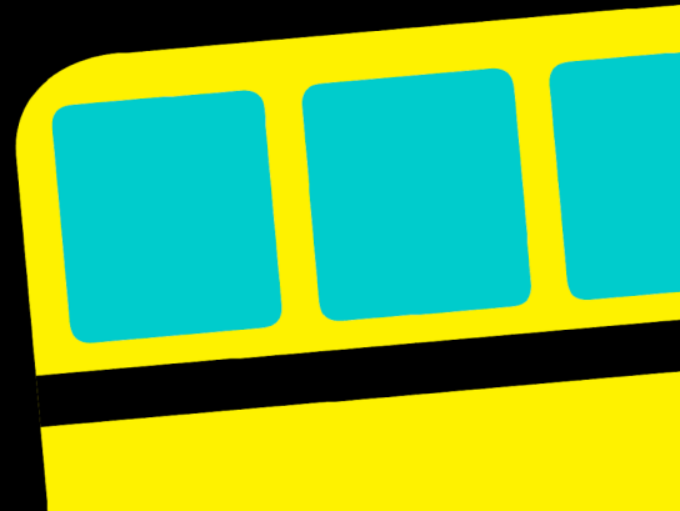
